



A Message from the Chief Justice's Commission on Professionalism

Please Read This Entire Message and Save It For Your Records

Greetings:

In this document, you will find information about CLE credit for the Suicide Awareness Program, which was convened by the Chief Justice's Commission on Professionalism on **Friday, April 30, 2021, from 2:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. via the Zoom.us** platform. The CLE qualifies for 3.0 general CLE hours, including 1.0 professionalism CLE hours for those who participated in the entire 3-hour CLE.

INFORMATION ON OBTAINING CLE CREDIT

The Commission will submit attendance information to the State Bar of Georgia's CLE Department for Georgia Bar members who **attend the entire** 3.0 hours CLE **not more than 10 business days AFTER the date of the CLE**, once the Commission confirms your participation in the CLE via the Zoom.us reports. There may be a delay in reporting CLE attendance for attendees who do not attend the entire CLE because it takes more time to calculate and report partial attendance.

To maintain the CLE credit on your CLE transcript, please visit www.gabar.org and click on the "Member Login" Button in the top right-hand corner. After you are logged in, look for the Blue "My Account" Box to the left. Click on the first link, "CLE Status." If you attended the entire CLE, the Chief Justice's Commission will send your attendance report to the State Bar of Georgia **not more than 10 business days AFTER the date of the CLE**, once the Commission confirms your participation in the CLE via the Zoom.us reports. There may be a delay in reporting CLE

attendance for attendees who do not attend the entire CLE because it takes more time to calculate and report partial attendance. Once the Bar receives your attendance report, you will have the option to pay the \$4 per CLE hour fee to have the CLE remain on your transcript. The fee is not due until December 31st, so please do not be alarmed if you do not immediately see an amount due on your transcript that allows you to pay. If you do not see the CLE on your transcript after May 21, 2021, please e-mail kygrier@cjcpga.org.

The Commission does not automatically send Certificates of Attendance to CLE attendees; the Commission only reports your attendance to the State Bar of Georgia's Commission on Continuing Legal Competency. The Commission will not apply to any state other than Georgia for CLE course approval. If you seek CLE credit from another state, you will need to do so on your own.
