Judge Eric Richardson serves on the State Court of Fulton County. Governor Nathan Deal appointed Judge Eric Richardson to the Fulton County State Court in August 2013. In May 2018, Judge Richardson was elected without opposition to a second four-year term. As a State Court Judge, he presides over misdemeanor criminal cases, including DUI and domestic violence offenses. Judge Richardson also presides over a wide variety of civil cases, including medical malpractice, products liability, fraud, complex business disputes, and personal injury actions.

Judge Richardson earned his Bachelor's degree in philosophy from the University of Rochester. He earned his law degree, cum laude, from Cornell Law School. Judge Richardson began his legal career as a litigator at Latham & Watkins in New York City in 1994. In 1998, he relocated to Troutman Sanders in Atlanta, where he spent 11 years, including 7 as a litigation partner. In 2009, he moved to the public sector, joining the city of Atlanta as a Senior Assistant City Attorney. He was promoted in 2011 to Deputy City Attorney for Atlanta, where he managed all litigation for the city until his appointment to the bench.

Judge Richardson lives in Johns Creek with his wife of 31 years, Karen, and has three adult children.
