Thank you for pre-registering for ***State Bar of Georgia President Sally Akins Signature Professionalism CLE Program***, a CLE being sponsored by the Chief Justice's Commission on Professionalism on **Wednesday, February 22, 2023, from 11:50 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. both in-person and Via the Zoom.us platform**. The CLE qualifies for 4.0 general CLE hours, including 2 professionalism hours for attendees who attend the entire 4-hour CLE.

INFORMATION REGARDING CLE CREDIT

The Commission will submit attendance information to the State Bar of Georgia's CLE Department for Georgia Bar members who **attend the entire 4.0 hours CLE not more than 10 business days AFTER the date of the CLE, once the Commission confirms your participation in the CLE via the in-person sign in sheets and the Zoom.us reports**. There may be a delay in reporting CLE attendance for attendees who do not attend the entire CLE because it takes more time to calculate and report partial attendance.

The Commission will pay the CLE fees due to the State Bar of Georgia's CLE Department for the 02-22-23 Signature Professionalism CLE.

YOUR CLE TRANSCRIPT IS SEPARATED BY YEAR

Your CLE transcript is separated by year. Ensure that you scroll down to the **2023** section of your CLE transcript to look for this CLE on your transcript. If you have scrolled down to the **2023** section of your CLE transcript and you still do not see this CLE on your transcript after **March 14, 2023**, please e-mail kygrier@cjcpga.org.

The Commission does not automatically send Certificates of Attendance to CLE attendees; the Commission only reports your attendance to the State Bar of Georgia's Commission on Continuing Legal Competency. The Commission will not apply to any state other than Georgia for CLE course approval. If you seek CLE credit from another state, you will need to do so on your own.
